Colbert County

APC Forest Products, a full-service manufacturer of wooden pallets is increasing their labor force by 10% with the addition of a hand-built crew.

DeKalb County

Renfro Corporation will be creating 442 additional jobs through a contract with Wal-Mart to produce socks sold under various brands. This announcement will push their employment in Fort Payne to over 1,000.



Lawrence County The Jack Daniel Cooperage announced a \$2,700,000 equipment upgrade. The project includes installing an automated

scanning / defecting rip cell that ties into existing equipment. This will allow the system to scan material and make decisions on how to cut the wood based on specifications entered into the system. The new technology will lead to less waste and better quality in the product. Other benefits are automated data collection and automated material handling.

Madison County

Aerojet Rocketdyne is expanding to manufacture the new AR1 rocket engine. Creating 100 additional jobs, the current decision to manufacture this engine in North Alabama makes this development the company's third announcement in the "Rocket City" in the past year.

IBM won a \$62 million contract with the Army to complete a pilot program that will consolidate current data centers and upgrade IT infrastructure at Redstone Arsenal.

Raytheon has been awarded a \$235 million U.S. Navy contract for Standard Missile-6 production at their assembly site on Redstone Arsenal.

AT&T is adding 40 full-time customer service jobs at its DirectTV Call Center currently employing 551 in Huntsville.
